Course Description:

This course is designed to make students study the development of common law concepts of enforceable promises and statutory impact. It encompasses the basic principles controlling the formation, performance, and termination of contracts. It includes the doctrines of offer & acceptance, consideration, conditions, breach, damages, and specific remedies available under Indian contract-related jurisprudence. It analyzes the various definitions of 'contract' in order to identify the best approach to understanding the subject.

The objective is to analyze the Indian law of contract in order to compare it with the English law. It seeks to peruse the role of the state in regulating freedom of contract in order to understand the need for such interference.

The course outline includes topics like privity of contract; validity, discharge and performance of contract, and remedies and quasi contracts, to name a few.
