Course Structure

This is a course designed for those who expect to work in or have business in Urdu-speaking countries and need to be able to communicate with Urdu speaking colleagues. This course is ideal for students who already have an advanced level of Urdu. Students will also be trained in skills such as appropriate language in telephone and office communication, while addressing cultural issues, and for social contexts. The objectives for the penultimate module are for students to learn how to analyze passages written in Urdu of intermediate difficulty, and to illustrate at an intermediate level both, their writing, as well as their spoken skills. The primary methods of teaching will once again be in the classroom with group discussions regarding terms and concepts being a priority along with the utilization of audio-visual aids and paper presentation and analysis.
